



**Nassau County Chamber of Commerce
'GIVE THE GIFT OF LOCAL' CAMPAIGN
CONTEST/DRAWING RULES
November 23, 2019 through December 31, 2019**

1. Contest is subject to federal, state and local regulations, taxes and associated fees, and is void where prohibited. Winner is fully responsible for all applicable federal, state and local taxes, as well as any fees, gratuities or prize related costs not specifically outlined in the prize description.
2. Contest winner must claim their prize in person during normal business hours by Tuesday, December 31, 2019 unless specified differently during the execution of a specific contest event. In the event of unusual circumstances, the Chamber reserves the right to extend this period to another specified deadline.

Winner must present proper identification (valid driver's license or photo identification) in person at Nassau County Chamber of Commerce, 961687 Gateway Blvd. Suite 101G; Amelia Island, Florida 32034. Winner will be required to execute an affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release of Nassau County Chamber of Commerce from any further obligation. If winner does not notify the Nassau County Chamber of Commerce by December 31, 2019 they forfeit the win.
4. Acceptance of prize constitutes winner's permission to use the winner's name and likeness for advertising and publicity purposes without additional compensation.
